The core curriculum is college preparatory and emphasizes academic excellence and effective preparation for success in college. The academic program is geared to meet college admission requirements and surpasses state education high school requirements. Students need a minimum of 230-240 units (over a four-year period) to graduate and must have a passing grade in all required courses.
