

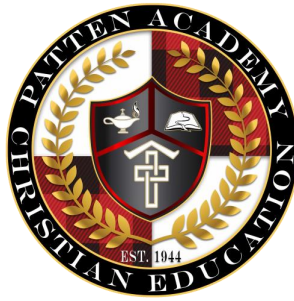

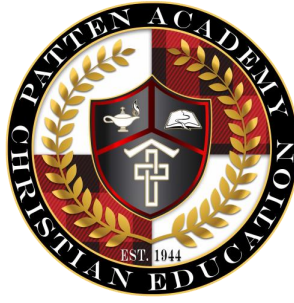

Note:

Families with one or more children pay according to the rates listed. Rates are calculated chronologically, from the oldest child (first child rate) to the youngest.

For parents who plan to make monthly payments, an additional \$50.00 Bookkeeping Fee is due with the first installment. Fall last installment is due no later than December 4, 2023 and spring last installment is due no later than May 3, 2024.

*International students on I-20's will pay a published tuition and appropriate fee scale (see separate I-20's brochure).



EXPLANATION OF FEES AND OTHER COSTS

TUITION: will cover basic educational costs, such as salaries, administrative costs, building & equipment maintenance, utilities, classroom expense, educational materials & programs for all grades.

FEES & OTHER COSTS:

APPLICATION FEE: (Non-refundable) of \$50.00 (\$100.00 for I-20 applicants) must accompany each enrollment application. A student cannot be tested nor is considered for enrollment until this fee is paid.

ENROLLMENT FEE: of \$200.00 (\$300.00 for I-20 applicants) for each new student is due when each child is accepted. The balance on the tuition & fees is due on or before Aug. 5th. Continuing students are to pay a \$100.00 Re-Enrollment fee which is due on or before April 15th.

BOOKKEEPING FEE: of \$50.00 is charged for the year for those parents paying by the month or \$25.00 by the term. This fee is due with your first installment.

LATE FEE: See contract for explanation of extensions on tuition and late penalties. Parents, who sign up for a payment plan need to make consistent payments according to their agreed upon contract.

TEXTBOOKS: K-5 grades will pay \$300.00 and 6-12 grades will pay approximately \$300.00 - \$400.00 per year for textbooks.

UNIFORMS: All students grade K-12 are required to purchase their uniforms. The cost of uniforms is approximately \$200.00 - \$250.00.

ATHLETIC FEE: There is an athletic participation fee per sport and a minimum uniform rental fee depending on the sport/s.

MUSIC REGISTRATION FEE: \$335.00 for 4th & 5th grade; \$395.00 for 6th-12th grade. Optional: You may also make monthly payments.

INSTRUMENT RENTALS: We offer a limited number of instruments to be rented at \$200.00 for 9 months August – May.

GRADUATION COSTS: Seniors \$200.00, 8th Grade \$125.00, and Kindergarten \$75.00

PROMOTION COST: 5th Grade \$100.00

*Graduation and Promotion Costs are both due at registration



STUDENT ID: The student ID card fee is \$2.50 due with first installment.

EMERGENCY EARTHQUAKE KIT: Parents are required to purchase one kit per child through the school. Kits will be stored on campus and have a shelf life of 5 years. Cost of \$20.00 per kit.

FIELD TRIPS: Fees for field trips vary according to class and event. Parents will be notified in advance by the teachers about upcoming trips.

P.A.S.S.: We have a daycare program before and after school. (Fees are not included in tuition.) If you are interested in this program, please see our office staff. All students are required to be under supervision while on campus. Any student left on campus before 8:15am and 15 minutes after end of school will be signed into daycare.

PROVISIONS:

All students Grades K-12 will be provided with necessary resources, services and testing materials that are administered yearly to provide a basis for evaluating the educational progress of each student.

Each student K-12 is covered with Accident Insurance which covers them while they are at school; travel to and from school for school sponsored activities.
